## Forest School After School Club – Years 3 & 4

We are excited to say that our popular Forest School After School Club is now open to Years 3 & 4. Forest School encourages the development of children's emotional and physical development through outdoor activities. The sessions will undertake tasks **(in all weather, excluding high winds and thunder storms)** such as shelter building, tree planting, bug hunting, knot tying as well as carefully guided activities around a campfire (including cooking and eating!) and the use of simple tools. All activities are checked for safety and risk assessments are carried out.

The club will be run by Mrs Emily Stiles, who is a qualified teacher and Forest School Leader. Mrs Stiles also runs her own forest school business, Hob's Bottom, and is looking forward to bringing her knowledge and expertise to our school. The club takes place every Wednesday 3.30 – 4.30pm. The first session will be on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> January and the last on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> February. **There are 16 places available and will be offered on a first come, first served basis. This is managed by Arbor and when the club becomes full, you will no longer be able to book a place. Please go to 'Quick Actions', click on 'Clubs' and select the appropriate club. Booking opens at 6pm on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January and closes at 6pm on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January.**

To have the most fun, children must have appropriate clothing for being outside in all weather. Suggested kit list includes shorts and t-shirt but, ideally legs and arms covered, in hot weather and a waterproof coat (with a hood), waterproof trousers, long sleeved top, trousers, warm socks, wellies, gloves and woolly hat for cold/wet weather. Please bring in a bag of suitable clothing ready for the first session. The children will change clothes after school, ready for the club, but please be aware that the children may come home muddy/wet/smelly (campfire) on these days as we will be unable to change them before you collect.

### Please Note:

- Children must be collected promptly from the office at 4.30pm. *Please be aware that the college gate and Lodmoor gate are now locked from 3.30pm so please use the main entrance on Coombe Avenue.*
- **Cancellation** – if a club is cancelled for any reason, you will receive an In-App Message. Please ensure that your Arbor App/Parent Portal is set up and you are able to read these messages.
- Permission slips – a link to an online form will be sent via email. Please ensure this is completed by someone with parental responsibility prior to the start date of the club.
- Please provide a drink and snack each week.
