This year at St John's we would like to support this special charity with the following;

- **Non-Uniform Day** – Friday 19th March will be a non-school uniform day. No hair dye please. Please bring in a donation for Red Nose Day, the suggested amount is 50p but whatever you can afford will be gratefully received. *Please bring donations in a sealed envelope labelled Non-Uniform Donation and give to a member of the nursery team.*
- **Red Noses for sale** – we have a limited supply of new 100% plastic-free noses available for children to buy in school on a 'first come first served basis'. With this in mind, please bring your money to school between 15th-18th March, a nose will be reserved for your child and then distributed to them on Friday 19th March. The noses cost £1.50 each and will be named with the children's initials so they are not mixed with other children's.
