Scholastic Book Fair

We are pleased to announce that we will be holding a Scholastic Book Fair, in school, where children will have an opportunity to select and buy quality books to take home and enjoy. There will also be a wide range of stationary items for children to purchase.

The Book Fair will start at 8.30am on Wednesday 26th March 2025 and the final day to visit will be at 3.15pm on Monday 31st March 2025. You will find the Book Fair in the school hall before school, 8.30-8.45am and after school, 3.15-3.30pm.

This year, you will be able to pay using your credit or debit card so please bring these along when you are visiting the book fair. We will also be accepting cash this year, although credit or debit card is preferred.

If you are unable to attend the fair, all children will have the opportunity to visit the book fair during the school day. They will create a 'wish list' which will then be shared with you. If you wish to purchase any items from the wish list, you will be able to scan the QR code and pay from the comfort of your own home. Once paid, please send the wish list back into school with your child, and include a note to let us know how much you have paid.

There is no obligation to purchase any of the books however, any funds raised will go back to school to purchase new books for our libraries.

<u>Reading Competition</u> – Once again, we will be holding a reading competition to see who can read a book in the most unusual place. We have 5 x £5 book fair vouchers as prizes, and these will be awarded to the top 5 most unusual places.
