The parent/guardian drop in session is an opportunity for you to have a **one-to-one** discussion with Lloyd and a member of his casework team about any issues or concerns you may have. Sessions will be held on a **first-come, first-served** basis and will last **10 minutes per person**.

Topics that can be discussed with an MP at an advice surgery include:

- ✓ Education and school funding
- ✓ Health and social care services
- ✓ Housing and local infrastructure
- ✓ Cost of living concerns
- ✓ Employment and workers' rights
- ✓ Policing and community safety
- ✓ Immigration and visa issues
- ✓ Benefits and social support

Lloyd holds these sessions in schools to ensure parents and guardians, who may find it difficult to attend regular surgeries due to work commitments, have the chance to raise concerns directly.
