- <u>Dress as a Superhero or wear something Red</u> Friday 18th March will be a non-school uniform day. <u>No hair dye please.</u> Please bring in a donation for Red Nose Day, the suggested amount is 50p but whatever you can afford will be gratefully received. *Please bring donations in a sealed envelope labelled Non-Uniform Donation and give to your class teacher or TA.*
