

The St John's Reading Challenge will start on Friday 11th October!

St John's Superstar Reading Challenge

Last year it was wonderful to see so many children earning their reading badges and completing the challenge.

What counts as a read?

Children in Key Stage 1 will need to read for 15 minutes to gain one 'read'. This can be made up of a 5 minute and 10 minute read put together in one day. Children can only do one 'read' per day.

Does the reading record need to be signed?


Yes! Only reads that are signed off by an adult and there should be an indication of how long the child has read for during that session (e.g. 20 mins, 15 mins etc).


How many reads are needed to get a badge?

For each of the circular button badges, children need to do 15 'reads'. For the gold, silver and bronze star badges 20 reads and a book review are needed.

The challenge starts on Friday 11th October and so <u>only reads from that date onwards</u> will count. Any reads before that date sadly cannot be included.

There are SIX coloured badges to collect. Collect them all to be a **SUPEr Star** reader!
