Dear Parents/Carers,

'Midsummer Night's Dream' Dress Rehearsal – Wednesday 8th February

I am sure you already know the children will be performing 'Midsummer Night's Dream' as part of The Shakespeare by the Sea Festival at Weymouth Pavilion. **On the morning of the 8th February, we need to be at the Pavilion. This is our official dress rehearsal. Please can you take your child directly to the Pavilion and staff will be there from 8.50am to receive them.** They need to be in school uniform, with their school bag and lunchbox. Please also provide a drink and a snack. We will bring any costumes etc. unless we have made alternative arrangements with specific children. Lunch will be eaten at school however, if your child has a free meal award or has ordered a hot meal for the day then Food Links will provide a packed lunch instead.

The morning will finish at **12 midday** and we will travel back to school by coach after the dress rehearsal and they will spend the afternoon in school, please collect at 3:15pm.

In the evening, the children need to be brought back to the Pavilion at 5.30pm. This is so they have time to get into their costumes and prepare for the evening performance.

The children will need to be collected at the end of all of the performances. This will be when both schools have finished and it should be at **about 8pm**. We will let you know exactly where the children need to be collected from nearer the time.

This really is a fantastic opportunity for the class and every child has their name on the Cast List that will be in the programme. Because of this it is essential that all children attend the dress rehearsal and the evening performance on 8th February. I am sure it will be an opportunity to feel really proud of all of the children.
