Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 5 Windsurfing Tuesday 5th July 2022

On Tuesday 5th July the children will take part in a Windsurfing session at the National Sailing Academy, Portland. The coach will leave at 9am and return to school before the end of the school day. The children will be very closely supervised with a high adult/child ratio and will be learning in very shallow water by the actual sailing school.

The cost of the trip is £5 per child. This is a voluntary contribution however, if we do not collect enough funds the trip will be unable to go ahead. Pupil Premium children will receive a discount and the total cost payable is £4.25. Please book and pay for your child's place via The Arbor App. Please go to 'Quick Actions', click on 'Trips' and select 'Year 5 Windsurfing'.

What your child will need:

- A packed lunch, if your child has a free meal entitlement or if you have already ordered a hot meal for this day then Food Links will provide a packed lunch option.
- A filled water bottle, clearly named.
- A towel and swimming costume. Traditional swim trunks should be worn for boys and traditional costumes for girls. Baggy shorts or bikinis are not suitable.
- Wetsuits will be provided however, you may bring your own if you prefer.
- A change of underwear for after the session.
- Any asthma inhalers & allergens medications.
- Sun cream. (Please apply this at home).
- Children should wear their school PE kits over the top of their swimming costumes.
- Old trainers or water shoes in a carrier bag. These will get wet.

Please complete and return the attached reply slip as well as the Risk Statement Form by Wednesday 29th June to the class teacher or TA.
