Primary College: Information for Parents

We are very excited to confirm that Year 6 children will be taking part in Primary College this year, Wednesday 12th, Thursday 13th and Friday 14th July.

The PTA are heavily subsidising the cost of this fantastic opportunity meaning that we will need to ask for a non-refundable, voluntary donation of £10 from parents/carers. Please book and pay for your child's place via The Arbor App by Thursday 6th July. Please go to 'Quick Actions', click on 'Trips' and select 'Year 6 Primary College'.

Please send your child with a packed lunch and a refillable drink bottle each day. If your child has a free meal entitlement or if you have already ordered a hot meal for this day then Food Links will provide a packed lunch option, a drinks bottle will still need to be provided.

Children will need to be dropped off and collected at the usual times at school. The children will walk to and from Weymouth College with school staff during school hours.

What is Primary College?

Primary College is a three-day programme of thirty different workshops (listed below) provided for children in Year 6 at Weymouth College. Children complete two workshops each day.

Primary College this year is on Wednesday 12th, Thursday 13th and Friday 14th July.

The aims of Primary College are to give all children taking part:

- an enjoyable and instructive experience which will broaden their horizons
- an opportunity to meet and work with children from other schools developing their social skills and easing their transition to secondary school
- the chance to try new activities and learn new skills

Some workshops have specific clothing requirements:

- sturdy shoes or boots (i.e not trainers or open-toed shoes) for construction activities
- football gear for the football workshops
- loose clothing for other sports activities
- old clothes for art and other hands-on workshops which are likely to be messy
