## Primary College: Information for Parents

### What is Primary College?

Primary College is a three-day programme of forty different workshops (listed below) provided for children in Year 6 at Weymouth College. Primary College this year runs from Wednesday 13th to Friday 15th July, with children completing two workshops each day.

### The aims of Primary College

- a very enjoyable and instructive experience which will broaden their horizons.
- an opportunity to meet and work with children from other schools - developing their social skills and easing their transition to secondary school.
- the chance to try new activities and learn new skills.

### Food and drink

### Clothing

*Some workshops have specific clothing requirements:*

- sturdy shoes or boots (i.e. not trainers or open-toed shoes) for engineering/ construction activities.
- football gear for the football workshops.
- loose clothing for other sports activities.
- old clothes for art and other hands-on workshops which are likely to be messy.
