Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Sailing Friday 1st July 2022

On Friday 1st July, the children will take part in a Sailing session at the Andrew Simpson Centre, Portland. The coach will leave at 9am and return to school before the end of the school day. The children will be very closely supervised by a fully trained qualified RYA sailing instructors.

The cost of the trip is £5 per child. This is a voluntary contribution however, if we do not collect enough funds the trip will be unable to go ahead. Pupil Premium children will receive a discount and the total cost payable is £4.25. Please book and pay for your child's place via The Arbor App. Please go to 'Quick Actions', click on 'Trips' and select 'Year 6 Sailing'.

What your child will need:

- A packed lunch, if your child has a free meal entitlement or if you have already ordered a hot meal for this day then Food Links will provide a packed lunch option. Lunch will be eaten at the Sailing Academy.
- A filled water bottle, clearly named.
- A towel and swimming costume. Traditional swim trunks should be worn for boys and traditional costumes for girls. Baggy shorts or bikinis are not suitable.
- Wetsuits will be provided however, you may bring your own if you prefer.
- A change of underwear for after the session.
- Any asthma inhalers & allergens medications.
- Sun cream. (Please apply at home).
- Old trainers or water shoes in a carrier bag. These will get wet.
- Children should wear their school PE kits over the top of their swimming costumes

Please return the slip attached by Friday 24th June to the class teacher or TA and please also complete the indemnity form <https://bit.ly/3v8b2ts> (sent by email). Your child will NOT be able to sail without a completed form. Thank you.
