Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Visit to Brownsea Island – Tuesday 16th June

We are excited to be able to offer our Year 6 class an invaluable visit to Brownsea Island in Poole Harbour. Brownsea Island has spectacular views, thriving habitats including woodland, heathland and a lagoon which create a unique haven for wildlife, such as the rare red squirrel and a wide variety of birds.

We will be exploring the island and all that it has to offer on Tuesday 16th June.

The cost of the trip is being heavily subsidised by school therefore making the cost £13 per child. This includes travel via train, ferry and entry to Brownsea Island. Pupil Premium children will receive a further discount and the cost payable is £9.50. This is a non-refundable voluntary contribution however, if we do not collect enough funds to cover the cost of the trip, we will be unable to go ahead. Please book and pay for your child's place via The Arbor App. Please go to 'Quick Actions', click on 'Trips' and select 'Year 6 Brownsea Island Visit'. Please complete the reply slip attached and return to Year 6 by Friday 15th May.

All children will need to be dropped off at Weymouth train station at 8am. Our train is due back at 4.16pm (16.16pm), please ensure an adult is at the station ready to collect or that permission is given overleaf for them to walk home. A mobile phone will be permitted on the trip for the purpose of walking home only and must be switched off for the duration of the trip. All mobile phones taken will be at the owner's responsibility.

All children will need to be wearing full school uniform including a jumper/cardigan, wearing comfortable shoes with a packed lunch, drink, snack and a sun hat and cream/coat weather permitting. If your child has a free meal entitlement or if you have already ordered a hot meal for this day then Food Links will provide a packed lunch option.
